

MCC to MU Transfer Agreement in Business Administration

A maximum of 64 credit hours will be accepted by MU from MCC to be applied to the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration. Students must complete 30 of the last 36 hours in residence at MU, enrolled in MU College of Business courses.

Admission into the upper level emphasis area is competitive; students must have a 2.6 UM cumulative GPA to apply, but that does not guarantee admission. Capacity is determined by each of the individual departments. Alternate business related majors are available to students who do not gain admission to College of Business Programs which would build on the same course work specified by this agreement.
