

MACC to MU Transfer Agreement in General Studies

A maximum of 66 credit hours will be accepted by MU from MACC to be applied to the Bachelor of General Studies for all component areas except the sciences. Students completing their first component area at MACC in Biological or Physical Sciences may complete an additional course (up to 70 credits) to accommodate their general education and component area requirements. Students must complete 30 of the last 36 hours in residence at MU, enrolled in MU courses approved for the BGS program.

Transfer students from MACC who have completed the Associate of Arts with an approved component area for transfer to the BGS program, upon acceptance into the Bachelor of General Studies program, will have junior standing at MU.

Students planning to transfer from MACC to the BGS program must complete one component of at least fifteen hours in a single subject, nine hours of which must be at the sophomore level (200 level).

SECTION III: PROGRAM PLAN

Students falling under this program articulation agreement will be responsible for successful completion of their Associate of Arts degree, including the completion of one specified academic component areas for application to the BGS degree, as follows:

Components II and III: Completed at MU = Minimum of 30 credits

* Of all component credits, at least 18 credits must be Arts & Science coursework.

* In the approved list of MACC transfer components all but Education courses are considered Arts & Science by MU.

* 18 credits of 3000 level MU component coursework (9 credits in each component) must be included.

* 3 credits of 3000 level MU component coursework must be a designated as Writing Intensive (WI)

Remaining BGS & Arts and Science Foundation Requirements: Completed at MU

* One Arts and Science Foundation Course at the 2000 level (3 credits)

* One 3000 level Capstone course (3 credits)

* Elective hours (20 credits)

* A minimum of 30 credits of MU coursework must be 3000 level. Of this 30 a minimum of 18 credits including the capstone must be in components, with the additional 12 credits in foundation, elective or component courses.

Minimum number of credits required for baccalaureate degree: 120 credits
