

MACC to MU Transfer Agreement in Social Work

A maximum of 64 hours credit will be accepted by MU from MACC to be applied to the Bachelor of Social Work. Thirty of the last 36 hours prior to graduation must be completed in residence at MU.

Transfer students from MACC who have completed the Associate of Arts degree, upon acceptance into the Bachelor of Social Work Professional Program at MU, will have junior standing at MU. Transfer students must have earned at least a 2.50 cumulative grade point average for admission into the School of Social Work. Additionally, transfer students must have earned at least a grade of “C- or above” in the following courses at MACC: English I, Exposition, Public Speaking I, College Algebra, Elementary Statistics, Macroeconomics, Biology, Introduction to Philosophy, Sociology, and General Psychology. Admission to the MU BSW Professional Program is competitive and not guaranteed. Applicants must submit a separate application including personal statement and references between February 1 – July 15 for fall admission. Transfer students are accepted into the BSW Professional Program only in the fall semester.
