

TRCC to MU transfer agreement in Elementary Education

Thirty of the last 36 semester hours of credit must be completed at MU (residency requirement) to be applied to the Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education.

Transfer students from TRCC, meeting the criteria listed below, upon acceptance into the teacher education program at MU, will have Phase II (professional) standing at MU for the Elementary Education degree program.

Criteria for Admittance to Phase II of the Teacher Development Program:

- Satisfactory completion of EDUC110 Introduction to Teacher Education, EDUC270 Technology for Teachers, EDUC130 Foundations of Education, EDUC 210 Teaching, Learning and Assessment, and EDUC 280 Portfolio Seminar
- Completion of Education courses with a cumulative GPA of 2.500 or higher
- An overall cumulative GPA of 2.750
- An ACT composite score of 22 or higher or SAT score of 1010 or higher
- A score of 235 or higher on each subtest of the C-Base exam (The C-Base exam must be completed prior to transfer because all sections must be passed before entering Phase II.)

General information regarding the C-Base exam:

A student who does not meet the minimum required score may retake that section(s). Students will have two years from the first testing period to retake those portions of the exam in which they must raise their score. After two years, the entire exam must be retaken. A passing score is a Missouri Teacher Certification requirement. It is recommended students take this test after completing 45 hours of college credit. All sections must be completed and passed prior to transfer to MU.

- Completion of ENGL112 Advanced College Writing with a “C” range grade.
- Completion of MATH163 College Algebra with a “C” range grade.
- Completion of BUAD230 Business Statistics with a grade of “C” or higher
- Satisfactory completion of the A.A. Teacher Education Portfolio
- Completion of Application for Progression into Phase II of the MU Teacher Development Program. The application need to be submitted to the College of Education the semester prior to transfer from TRCC to MU (i.e. for Fall 2006 entrance, the application needs to be submitted in the Spring 2006 semester)
