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## Transfer Admission Requirements

- Transfer students who meet MU's freshman admission requirements must have a 2.5 transfer GPA in college-level courses to be admitted.
- Transfer students who do not meet MU's freshman admission requirements must have:
  - A minimum of 24 transferable college-level credits;
  - A 2.5 GPA in transferable college-level courses; and
  - Either College Algebra with a C- or better or the equivalent to MU's English 1000 with a C- or better.
- Transfer students with an associate of arts (AA) degree from a regionally accredited Missouri community college are considered to have met the general transfer admission requirements.

All students are required to complete an internship placement, normally taken during the last year of study and after completing all core courses and the pre-internship course.
