NOTE: Many international students do not enroll for summer school. Therefore, tuition, fees, books and supplies are not included in summer estimated costs.

The University of Missouri charges a flat tuition rate based on a student's program of study, permitting a student to take 12-18 credits per term. There are three tiers with \$945 per semester (\$1,890 per year) being the increment of increase between each tier.

These figures are subject to change without notice.

Students are charged a one-time enrollment fee of \$300 USD.

International students studying on an F-1 visa are permitted to work on campus up to 20 hours per week during the fall and spring academic terms. The wage and number of hours per week will vary by position. The minimum wage is currently \$12.30 per hour.
