

Transfer to Mizzou Major-Specific Admission Guide

This guide is for informational and planning purposes only. It may not be possible to offer admission to all qualified applicants in a degree program because of a competitive applicant pool and space limitations.

Transfer Admission Requirements

To be admitted to Mizzou as a transfer student, you must first meet any of the following criteria:

- Have a 2.5 GPA on completed college-level credits AND EITHER a grade of C- or better in a transferable math course (intermediate algebra or higher or statistics), OR a grade of C- or better in a transferable English composition course (English comp 1 or higher).
- o If you have completed fewer than 24 college-level credits, you must also meet MU's <u>freshman admission</u> requirements in addition to the criteria above.
- A 2.0 GPA from a UM school OR
- Transfer from a regionally accredited Missouri or border state college with a 2.0 GPA AND EITHER an associate of arts (AA) degree OR the Missouri CORE 42. General education requirements will be considered fulfilled.

General admission to Mizzou does not guarantee admission to an individual degree program, which often has its own admission requirements. Transfer students may be admitted to the University as Exploring students if the desired program prerequisites are not met or if the preferred major has filled to capacity. Students with 75 or more earned credit hours cannot be admitted to the University as undeclared students.

Planning Your Coursework

RECOMMENDED COURSES: Several majors require specific course completion prior to admission to the program.

COURSE ARTICULATION: To find course equivalences, please review **transfercourses.missouri.edu.**

CORE 42 Completion: If a student has the CORE 42 completion designation from a public (and participating independent) two- or four-year college or university in Missouri and a 2.0 GPA then they met our general admission requirements and will be accepted by the University as having completed MU's General Education requirements (like the AA degree).

Veterans: A veteran or military service member with fewer than 24 graded college-level credits and does not meet MU's first-time college admissions requirements, may apply for admission after successful completion (minimum 2.5 GPA) of 12 hours of coursework at an accredited college/university, including the completion of transferable English or math course (unless already earned) with a grade of C- or better.

Nontraditional Students: An applicant who has not been enrolled full-time at any college or university for at least four years, and does not meet MU's first-time college admissions requirements, may apply for admission after successful completion (minimum 2.5 GPA) of 12 hours of coursework at an accredited college/university, including the completion of a transferable English or math course (unless already earned) with a grade of C- or better.
